DID YOU KNOW?

Outdoor Winter Activities For the Whole Family

- Sliding Hills** – Oromocto is home to two sliding hills. One is located at Anniversary Park and the other is located behind Gesner Street School.
- Outdoor Rinks** – The Town is fortunate to now have 3 outdoor rinks for recreational activities (weather permitting.) The main outdoor rink is located on Winnebago Street at the tennis courts. The other two are located at Anniversary Park and Deer Park.
- Groomed Trails at the Gateway Wetlands, Anniversary Park, Deer Park and the Great Trail of Canada** – In support of our active-transportation plan, the Town grooms these walking trails to enable its residents to enjoy the outdoors as much as possible in the Winter.
- Snowmobile Trail** – From December 15 through to April 15, the Town opens its trail to all New Brunswick Snowmobile Federation permit holders. Many of the goods and services needed for snowmobilers are available right along Oromocto’s provincial route which connects to the other NBSF provincial trails.



CAUTION! Oromocto is located along two major river systems. It is very tempting to want to go out on the ice for recreational purposes. Due to its instability, caused by fluctuations in the river system, citizens are reminded that the ice can be extremely dangerous and to avoid it. Should an incident occur, the Oromocto Fire Department is well prepared to respond to ice rescues.



Snow Removal – The Town has exceptional snow removal services. It strives to have its roads cleared as quickly as possible. The Town’s snow and ice removal plan priorities are based on the importance of streets to Oromocto’s overall transportation network. The department provides plowing and sanding/salting services according to the following priorities:

1. Major Arteries and Hospital Routes (example: Waasis Road)
2. Collector Streets (example: Black Watch Avenue)
3. Residential Streets and Minor Roads (example: Craig Street).

The Town plows and sands many of the sidewalks, pathways and nature trails. Priority is given to sidewalks in school areas and along main streets.

Snow Gates – Oromocto is one of a few communities in Canada that utilizes ‘snow gates.’ Snow gates should normally reduce the amount of snow deposited in driveways. Their use may not work as well during some snow events.
