## **BY-LAW 208**

## A BY-LAW OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF OROMOCTO TO ESTABLISH A CURFEW

**BE IT ENACTED** by the Mayor and the Councillors of the Town of Oromocto as follows:

- 1. In this By-Law "child" means a person under sixteen years of age.
- 2. No child shall be in a public place in the Town of Oromocto after 22 00 hours unless he is accompanied by an adult person.
- 3. Any child found in a public place in the Town of Oromocto in violation of Section 2 may be ordered by any peace officer or constable to go home or be taken to a children's shelter.
- 4. Every parent, guardian or any other person having the care, custody or control of any child who violates this By-Law is guilty of an offence, and is liable to a penalty not exceeding five dollars (\$5.00) for the first offence, and not exceeding ten dollars (\$10.00) for each subsequent offence.
- 5. The Town of Oromocto Police Station shall be the children's shelter for the purpose of this By-Law.
