Voient Alert! Is a multi-purpose communication service provided by the Town of Oromocto to keep you informed of critical events like fires or floods as well as day-to-day communications such as road maintenance and closures, sports facility closures, water advisories, etc.

Voient Alert! allows you to create and follow multiple locations such as “Kids School” or “Mom’s House”. Any event or communication related to your followed locations will be forwarded to you along your preferred communication channel.

### OROMOCTO COUNCIL MEETINGS RECORDINGS

### OROMOCTO HEALTH CARE RECRUITMENT ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Council agreed to fund an incentive of \$13,220 (thirteen thousand two hundred twenty dollars) and direct staff to allocate \$26,400 (twenty-six thousand four hundred dollars) annually, for the recruitment of healthcare professionals to a maximum of two agreements per fiscal year until 31 December 2027.

### BARRIERS PURCHASED FOR TRAILS

The Town Engineer purchased and installed jersey barriers at each of the five NB Trail gate locations and one near the highway tunnel, for an unbudgeted cost of \$8,880.

1. Heidi Lawless-Anderson was hired as the new Human Resource Manager with her employment commencing 06 August 2024.
2. Cedric Boudreau was offered the position of Holiday Relief Firefighter in accordance with the IAFF Local 1576/Town of Oromocto Collective Agreement.
3. Firefighter Adam O'Blenes was promoted to the rank of Lieutenant, with the salary, benefits and terms of employment as defined within the IAFF 1576/Town of Oromocto Collective Agreement.
4. The Town's Performance Evaluation Reports Policy and the Disciplinary Action Policy were amended and approved by Council.

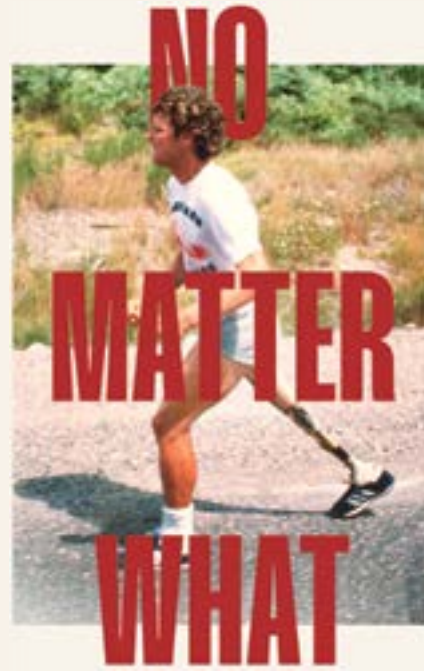
