Voyent Alert! Is a multi-purpose communication service provided by the Town of Oromocto to keep you informed of critical events like fires or floods as well as day-to-day communications such as road maintenance and closures, sports facility closures, water advisories, etc. Voyent Alert! allows you to create and follow multiple locations such as "Kids School" or "Mom's House". Any event or communication related to your followed locations will be forwarded to you along your preferred communication channel. Smart alerting capabilities ensure that you will only get notified when a communication is relevant to you or one of the locations you are following. Council Highlights

Town of Oromocto Strategic Plan 2026-2030

The Town Council, guided by TSI Solutions, has developed a four-year strategic plan to guide administration over their next term. Oromocto Regional Wellness and Recreation Centre (ORWRC) Design Approved

Council received a final design presentation of the ORWRC and authorized administration to proceed with the construction documents to be developed for the issuance of the tender to be released in the Fall.

Residential Housing Units Infrastructure Agreement

Council has authorized the Mayor and Clerk to enter into and execute the contribution agreements with the Government of Canada relating to the infrastructure upgrades for the residential housing units.

Accessible Kayak Launch

The Town has made application to the Assumption Life-MAC-Goguen Champlain Community Fund for the installation of an accessible kayak boat launch.

Dates Set for Public Presentation and Public Hearings of the Municipal Plan and Zoning By-Law

Council set the date for a public presentation of the proposed Municipal Plan By-Law Amendment 510-H to be held on Monday, 17 August 2026 at 5:30 pm in Council Chambers; and the subsequent Public Hearing of Written Objections to both the Municipal Plan By-Law Amendment 510-H and proposed Zoning By-Law Amendment 522-L that will be held in Council Chambers on Tuesday, 15 September 2026.
